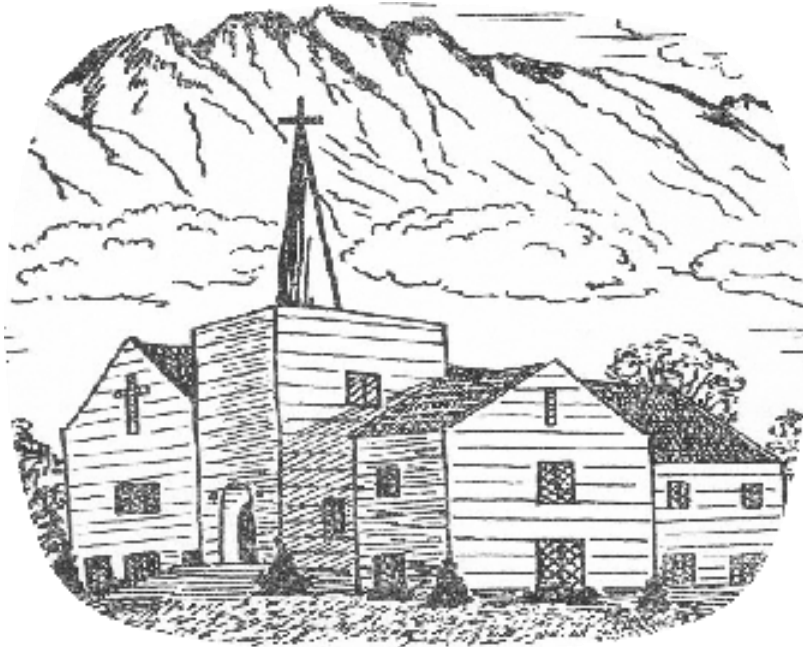


Welcome to Worship

P: Lift up your hearts

P: It is indeed right and salutary that we should at all times in all places give thanks and praise to God. In the night in which he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, gave thanks and gave it to his disciples saying: take, eat, this is my body given for you, do this for the remembrance of me. Again, after supper, he took the cup, gave thanks and gave it to them to drink saying: this cup is the new covenant in my blood shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sins, do this for the remembrance of me. O God of resurrection and new life: Pour out your Holy Spirit on us and on these gifts of bread and wine. Bless this feast. Grace our table with your presence. **All: Come, Holy Spirit** P: Reveal yourself to us in the breaking of the bread. Raise us up as the body of Christ for the world. Breathe new life into us. Send us forth, brimming with your grace, forgiveness and love.

P: Let us pray as Jesus taught us:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever and ever. Amen. P: Come to the banquet, for all now is ready!
