Dear Parents and students,

We are excited to have you join us on this adventure of exploring the story, Voyage of the Dawn Treader written by C.S. Lewis. The Chronicles of Narnia are a supposal, Lewis hypothesized that God and Jesus would appear to other worlds in ways that the inhabitants could relate to. In this case talking animals would most likely relate well to having a lion as their savior. The idea of God being like a lion is a simile found in the bible in these 10 locations; Hosea 11:10, Jeremiah 25:38, Hosea 5:14, Hosea 13:7, Hosea 13:8, Jeremiah 49:19, Jeremiah 50:44, Isaiah 38:13, Lamentations 3:10, and Job 10:16.

This is the 5th of 7 books in the series. The 7 stories are all connected the list below are numbered chronologically while the dates reflect the years they were published.

#2 The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe (1950), #4 Prince Caspian: The Return to Narnia (1951), #5 The Voyage of the Dawn Treader (1952), #6 The Silver Chair (1953), #3 The Horse and His Boy (1954), #1 The Magician's Nephew (1955), and #7 The Last Battle (1956). Similar to stories in the bible the books can be read out of order and have merit to stand alone. We selected this book because of the adaptability to everyday life and adventure it presents.

In our efforts to create this exciting week we want to take into consideration that creativity opens our minds up to new and fun ways to look at things. We intend on encouraging the creativity while instilling a clear sense that the bible is real and not fantasy. The ability to bring our faith into our way of thinking about fantasy is just as important as it is to live it out daily. By thinking of faith and our relationship with God in this way, we build a stronger foundation to draw from because it means we can see God's love in all things.

We intend on having a cap for our registration of approximately 25-30 participants over the age of 4.
